ORDER

Before the Court is defendant Heather Ann Tucci-Jarraf's unopposed motion for extension of time to file objections to the presentence report [Doc. 189]. The defendant's presentence report was filed on June 6, 2018 [Doc. 183]. Pursuant to Local Rule 83.9(c), both parties are required to file any objections to the presentence report within fourteen days of its entry—in this case, on or before June 20, 2018. *See* E.D. Tenn. L.R. 83.9(c). This deadline passed with no word from defendant, but on June 24, 2018, defendant filed the instant motion for permission to file her objections to the presentence report on or before June 27, 2018. In support of this motion, defendant argues that this extension will allow her additional time to confer with her standby counsel and will not interfere with the scheduled sentencing in this case. The government does not oppose defendant's motion.

For good cause shown, defendant's motion [Doc. 189] is **GRANTED**. Defendant may file objections to the presentence report on or before **June 27, 2018**.
